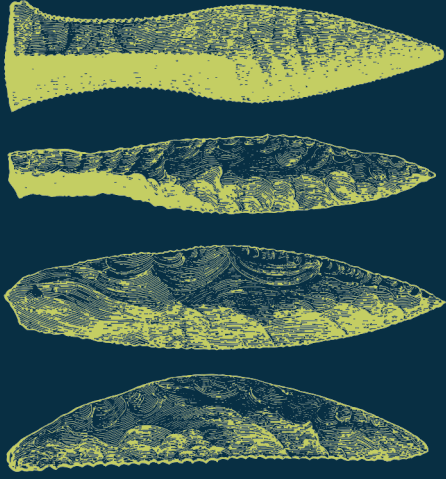

MANDATE

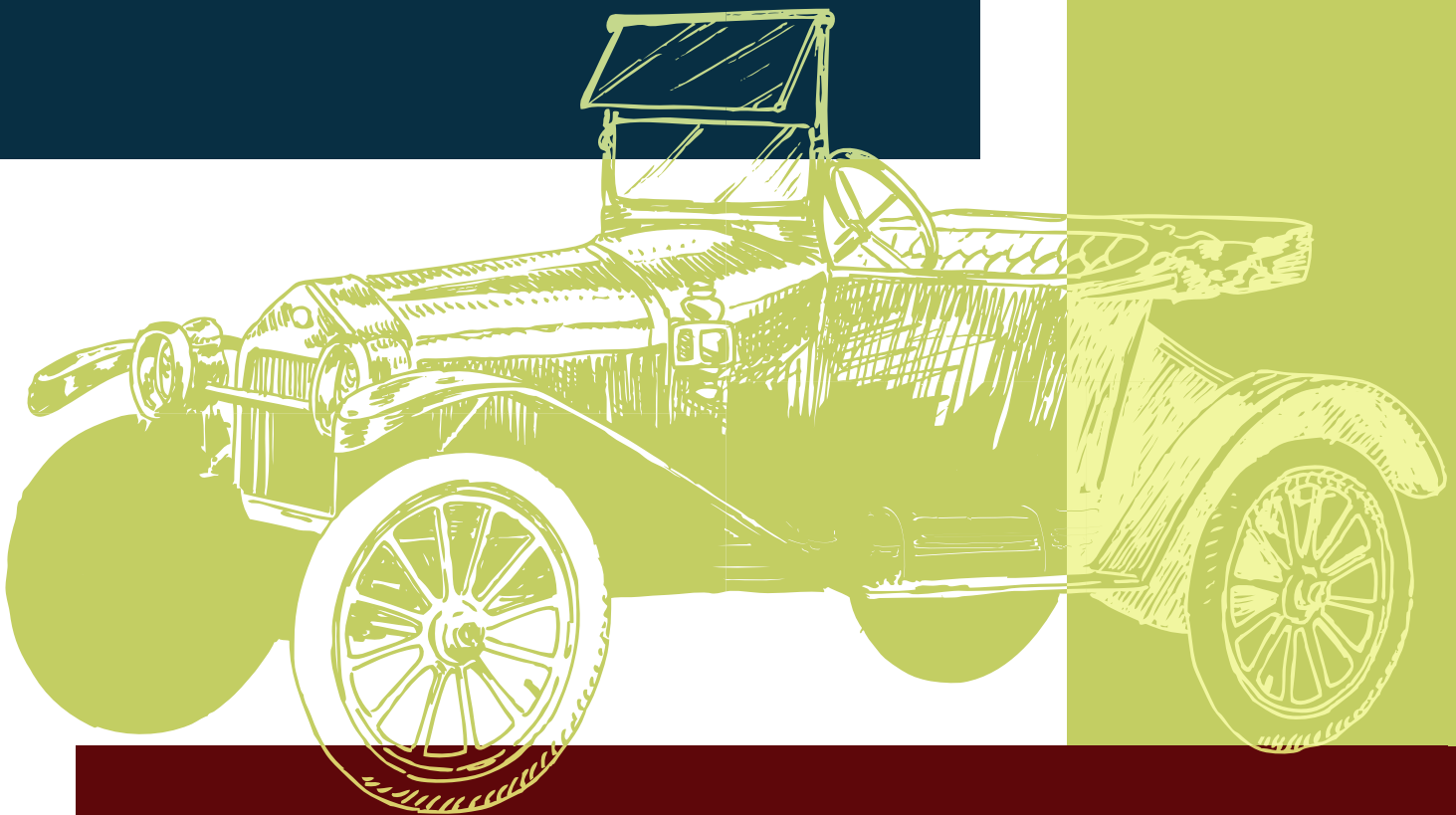
